SCENARIO 1: Employability

Last summer, you completed a work placement in a French bakery for 2 months. Upon your return to Scotland, you were asked to write a report on your experience for the bakery's website in **French**.

You must include the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- How you travelled to France
- What your job role included
- What your experience at the bakery was like
- What you liked/disliked about the job
- Why you chose to work in France
- If you would recommend a similar placement to others

You should write approximately 150-180 words

OR

SCENARIO 2: Learning

You have just returned from Quebec, after living there for 3 months. Now you are home, you have been asked to write in **French** about your experience at the school you attended, which was French speaking.

You must include the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- How you travelled and what you did during the journey
- What the area was like
- What your average day at school looked like
- How you got on with the other pupils
- What the hardest part of the experience was
- What you learnt from the experience

You should write approximately 150-180 words
