### SCENARIO 1: Learning

**You must include** the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- How you heard about the project
- How you financed the trip
- What the project entailed
- How you got on with the other volunteers
- Where you had dinner in the evenings
- Whether or not you would recommend the experience, and why

You should write approximately 150-180 words
