SCENARIO 1: Learning

You must include the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- How long you were away for, and how you travelled there
- How you financed your trip
- What inspired you to sign up for the course
- How you got on with other people on the course
- What the best aspect of the trip was
- How this experience will benefit you in the future

You should write approximately 150-180 words
