SCENARIO 1: Society

Last winter, you went to spend Christmas with your brother in Canada. You spent lots of time exploring and spending time with family. On your return, you have been asked to write about your experiences in **French** for your schools website.

You should write approximately 150-180 words

SCENARIO 2: Learning

Last term, you went on a school exchange in France. During your stay, you studied at a French school. On your return you were asked by your school to write an account of your experience in **French** for future students.

You must include the following information and you should try to add other relevant details:

- How you travelled and what you did during the journey
- Where you stayed and what you thought of the accommodation
- How you got on with the other students and teachers
- How French and Scottish schools differ
- What you did when you were not at school
- Whether or not you would return

You should write approximately 150-180 words
